

ABOUT THE ANNE RITA MONAHAN FOUNDATION

In 2001, Anne Rita Monahan was diagnosed with advanced stages of ovarian cancer after nearly a decade of misdiagnoses. After undergoing several different treatment types, she went into remission for 17 months, only to have the cancer return. She established the Anne Rita Monahan Foundation in 2007 to “ARM” women in the fight against this terrible disease.

Because the disease is often difficult to detect, ARM is dedicated to educating and raising awareness of the signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer in order to encourage its early detection and decrease cases of misdiagnosis. The ARM foundation also raises funds to aid in finding a reliable screening test for this disease and provides scholarships to promising young students interested in ovarian cancer research.

Sadly, on May 13, 2009 Anne passed away from this terrible disease. Those who worked with Anne are determined to continue raising awareness and funds in honor of her and all women afflicted with ovarian cancer.

- Story of a special/unique cancer journey/experience
 - The nominee **does not** have to be a person with ovarian cancer. The award can go to a relative (husband, daughter), friend, physician, etc.
- Display of volunteerism for cancer awareness and the community
- Role model for other cancer crusaders and/or community
- Determination/perseverance
